





National Girls Collaborative Project (NGCP)



Proven resources to increase girls' participation in STEM

- 14 Regional collaboratives
- 28 States served + DC
- 70 AAUW-led programs already connecting
- 130 Mini grants awarded to date, representing 8,000+ girls
- 242 Organizations involved in leading collaboratives
- 1600 Programs in the NGCP Program Directory
- 1670 Participants at 20 events across the U.S.
- 3.5 million Girls served by the programs connection through NGCP

LAF Plaintiff Support

LAF's new focus on supporting potentially precedent-setting cases has

- Expanded AAUW's reputation as a defender of fair treatment in the workplace
- Encouraged coalition partners to refer discrimination cases and seek AAUW support for amicus briefs.

LAF Campus Outreach Grants


