

# **LAF Plaintiff Support**

- Expanded AAUW's reputation as a defender of fair treatment in the workplace
- Encouraged coalition partners to refer discrimination cases and seek AAUW support for amicus briefs.

# **LAF Campus Outreach Grants**

AAUW is funding three campus outreach events in March and April on campuses in California and Washington.

- Events focus on pay equity, sexual harassment, and sexual assault on campus.
- AAUW branches can still apply for up to \$750 to host a campus event at any time.
