Yesterday the US Supreme Court gave a decision that should expand access to health care for many Americans.

FORTY YEAR CELEBRATIONS

Saturday, June 23, marked the 40th anniversary of the Pell Grant program, which was originally known as the Basic Educational Opportunity Grant and later renamed for Sen. Claiborne Pell (D-RI).

HOWEVER: In an effort to cut the federal deficit, several changes to the Pell Grant program will begin to take effect in July. These changes will reduce the number of students who are eligible for the tuition assistance program as well as the amount of money they can receive.
