### ChIPLEY Endowment

For the last 10 years, AAUW NC has worked to fund the Ann ChIPLEY endowment started by an AAUW national board in 1996. We are pleased to announce that the campaign reached stipend producing level (\$100,000) in December, 2016. This was a cooperative effort of the branches with support of friends from outside of North Carolina who also remember Ann. Of the \$12,411 contributed by AAUW North Carolina and branches in NC, all but \$125 was contributed to the ChIPLEY endowment that will start funding AAUW American and Selected Professions Fellowships in 2017-2018.
